Oak Class have been studying Kenya. Indie kindly brought in some Kenyan artefacts to share with the class. Looks fascinating!



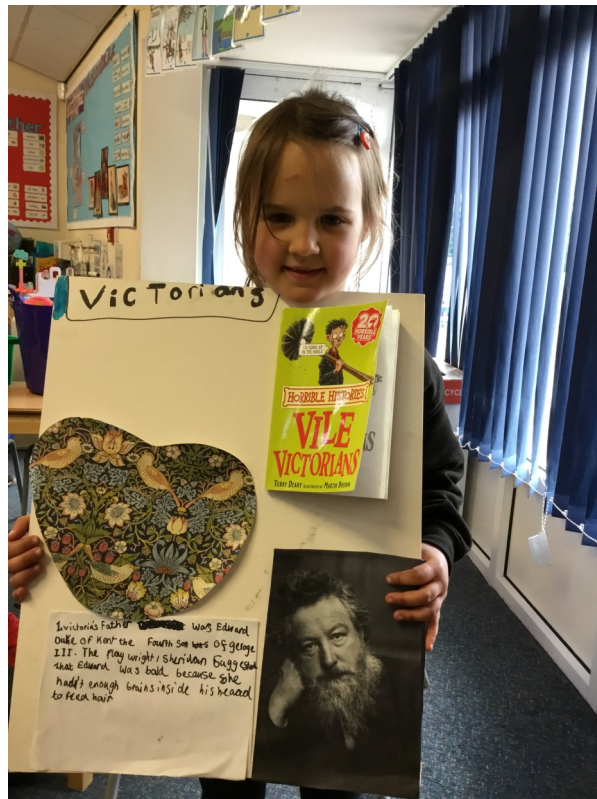
