Football - Pro Stars - WINNERS!


A huge well done to the year 3/4 football team that won the tournament last Friday!

Attendance and holidays in term time

We wanted to politely remind you that following the DFE guidance, the Local Authority's and the school's attendance policy, it is very likely you will receive a fine if you take your child out of school for 10 or more session (5 school days) within a 10 week period. We have been informed by the DFE that as of September the cost of the fine will be increasing as they try to tackle attendance issues. We will inform you of the changes once we have all the details.

If a pupil is absent due to illness immediately before or after a holiday then medical evidence may be needed for the days taken as sick. If this is not provided, the absence will be unauthorised and therefore a fine will still be given. It will then be down to parents to prove to the Local Authorities legal team that you were not away on holiday for those days. The Local Authority will issue a fine, if they have reasonable belief or evidence that parents are not being truthful and it is likely the child had taken a holiday. The Local Authority and DFE are really cracking down on this and are aware that some parents in the county are not being genuine about the absences.

This is not personal, it is a school policy following guidance issued by the DFE that we have to follow.
